

**NOTICE TO LINCOLN COUNTY PROPERTY OWNERS
PROPERTY TAX
DELINQUENT DATE**

LINCOLN COUNTY TREASURER reminds Lincoln County property owners, they must pay their Second Half Property Taxes by May 10, 2010 to avoid penalty and interest.

**ACCORDING TO N.M STATE STATUTE 7-38-83,
TIMELINESS-B. ALL ACTS REQUIRED
OR PERMITTED TO BE DONE BY MAIL
ARE TO BE POSTMARKED
ON THE REQUIRED DATE**

The Lincoln County Treasurer's Office does honor the postmark, but your mailed payment ***MUST BE POSTMARKED BY May 10, 2010.*** If you mail a payment on May 10, 2010, request the postmaster stamp the date in your presence, to insure the postmark of that date.

INTEREST shall accrue at the rate of one percent (1%) per month or any portion of a month. (Statute 7-38-49 NMSA 1979).

PENALTY on taxes that become delinquent, shall be imposed at one percent (1%) of the delinquent tax total, or a minimum of five dollars (\$5.00), for each month they remain unpaid. (Statute 7-38-50).

By N.M. State law, property taxes are the personal obligation of the property owner, whether or not the tax bill was received. Mail payments or contact us at the address and phone number below should you have questions regarding your property tax bills.
